## **Eligibility**

Clackamas County Farm Bureau Scholarships are available to any Clackamas County high school graduate, current county resident, or prior recipient. Required high school/college GPA of 2.8. Scholarship is available to people pursuing a career in agriculture or a related field.

## **Award Amount**

Scholarships of between \$1,000 and \$3,000 will be awarded per recipient. Up to \$15,000 in scholarships total will be awarded.

## **Scholarship Application**

Please include the following information in your submission. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

## **Information Requested**

1. High school transcript
2. College transcript (if applies)
3. Name of college attending or college(s) applying to
4. Two letters of recommendation will be required: one letter from an ag advisor or teacher and one personal recommendation from a non-relative.
5. A hand-written, one-page letter detailing reasons for pursuing a degree in agriculture or related field.
6. Resume detailing work experiences, volunteer work, leadership activities, and participation in 4-H, FFA, and other agricultural activities. Include in this resume any honors or recognition received. (Note: this document would be the same resume you would use in applying for employment.)
