## Two ag scholarships available

The Oregon Agricultural Education Foundation (OAEF) announces the availability of two scholarships for Oregon high school graduates attending a junior college or a four-year college or university in Oregon, with plans to pursue a career in the agriculture industry.

**Oregon Farm Bureau Memorial Scholarships** are open to new and continuing full-time students, who are pursuing an agriculture-related major. Two scholarship winners will receive \$1,500 and there will be a number of \$1,000 and \$750 award recipients, depending on available funds. (Typically, eight to 10 students are honored each year.) It is possible to reapply for the scholarship annually.

**Willamette Valley Ag Association Scholarships** are available to full-time students who are college-level juniors or higher, and are pursuing an agriculture-related major. A number of \$1,000 scholarships will be given, depending on available funds.

A current application must be used when applying for the Academic Year 07-08. The deadline is April 1.
