Oregon Agricultural Education Foundation utilizes Summer Agriculture Institute (SAI) to introduce agriculture to teachers with little or no agricultural experience. Applicants must be a TSPC licensed classroom teacher in a current teaching role. Agricultural Science and Technology teachers are not eligible for SAI. SAI costs over \$3,000 per participant, covering expenses such as tuition, lodging, transportation, and meals. With the generosity of program sponsors, the total cost of enrollment is \$800 (including a \$200 non-refundable deposit). The registration fee becomes non-refundable on and after May 1, 2024. Upon completion of the Institute and its requirements, participants will receive three graduate-level credits through Oregon State University.
